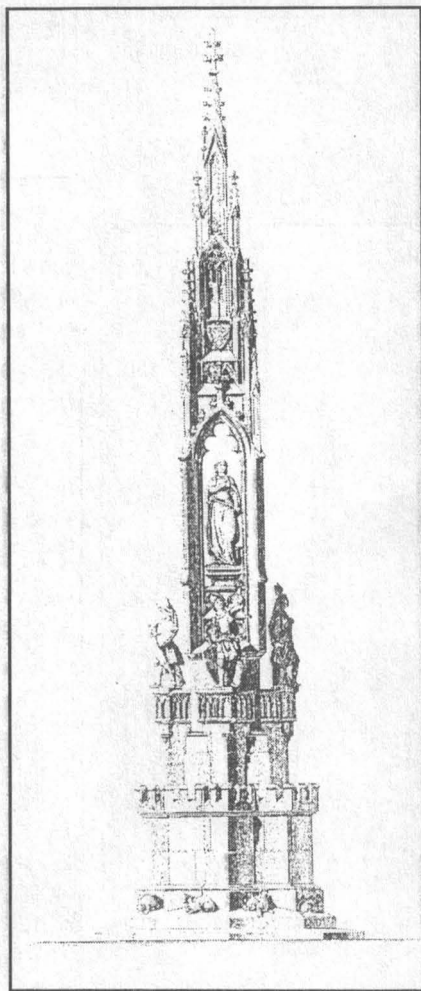
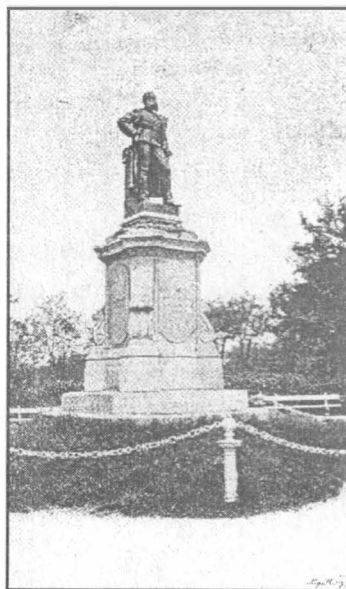


Fig. 1. Monumentul Militar austriac (litografie din *Rückblicke...*)



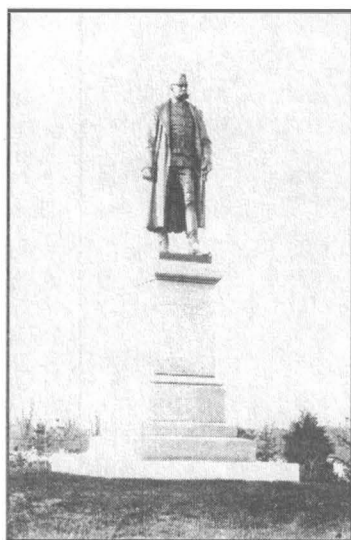
**Fig. 2.** L. Rohbock-L. Oeder – Piața cu monumentul neogotic
