

## THE “OVIDIU” SCOUT COHORT AT THE FIRST NATIONAL JAMBOREE (PIATRA NEAMȚ – 1930). IMPRESSIONS’ ALBUM

*Lavinia Dumitrașcu* \*

**Summary:** This article presents the "Ovidiu" Scouts Cohort from Constanța through an „impression album” from the First National Jamboree (Piatra Neamț - 1930). The album is part of the patrimony of the National History and Archaeology Museum of Constanța, being a donation of Marin Gh. Benghiuș, a scout and author of Romanian scout history.

**Keywords:** „Ovidiu” Cohort, jamboree, album, 1930, Romania.

Globally, the Scout movement was founded by Lord Baden-Powell in England in 1907. In Romania, this movement was “imported” by Professor Gheorghe Munteanu-Murgoci, who also got the Romanian Royal House involved in this movement. The first scout patrols were formed at the “Gheorghe Lazăr” High School in Bucharest and the movement gradually spread throughout Romania. In April 1915 the first Scouts’ Regulation was issued and, on 8 April, the law was passed which created the Romanian Scouts Association as a juridical body under the high patronage of King Ferdinand I. The Commander of the Great Legion was Prince Carol II, while the President was Adj. Col. Grigore Berindei<sup>1</sup>.

By Decree no. 961 of April 8, 1915, the Romanian Scouts Association, with 34 legions in all the counties, with 58 cohorts, 192 commanders and 12966 members was established. In Dobrogea, the "Queen Elizabeth" Legion, based in Constanța, consisting of the Constanța and Medgidia cohorts, was set up, while in Tulcea the "Ion Voda the Terrible" Legion was established, with the headquarters in Tulcea and the cohorts of Tulcea and Măcin.<sup>2</sup>

The scouts participated in the battles of the First World War on all fronts.

Romanian Scouts Association representatives attended the first two World Jamborees (London - 1920 Paris - 1922), Romania became a founding member of the World Organization of Scouting.

In 1922, prince Nicolae took the lead of the scout movement. In the same year, the Association of War Scouts 1916-1919 was established. A delegation, headed by Prince Nicholas, participated in the Third World Jamboree (England -1929).<sup>3</sup>

Taking as model these jamborees, Prince Nicholas organized such meetings on a national level, to be held every two years. Their preparation was entrusted to General Ion Manolescu, Deputy Commander of the Grand Legion, and Colonel Ulisse Sâmboteanu, Director of Scouting. The first national jamboree took place in 1930, in Piatra Neamț. They were followed by jamborees in: Sibiu - 1932, Mamaia - 1934, Brașov - 1936.

In 1937, King Carol II abolished the scout movement, replacing it with the guard movement.

The beginnings of the scouting movement in Constanța began in the autumn of 1915. The committee was chaired by magistrate V. Popovici, vice-presidents N. Negulescu - the Principal of "Mircea cel Bătrân" High School in Constanța - and Lt. Colonel Grigorescu.<sup>4</sup> The cohort was established by a teacher of the same High School, N. Constantinescu-Pană. The Legion was given the name "Queen Mary". The cohort originally consisted of 152 people, the vast majority of them being high school students. The motivation of the founder of the cohort for a small number of scouts was for it "not to be endangered in its beginnings by an agglomeration of unselected

elements." The activities organized by the Mircian scouts were aimed at making the principles of scouting and fundraising known. In this sense, they met every Friday at "Mircea cel Bătrân" High School, their gatherings including music shows, lectures, and conferences. On 8 March 1916, the swearing in of the "Ovidiu" cohort was attended by scouts from Sinaia, Bucharest, Galați and Focșani. This solemn event - transformed into a true celebration of the whole town - enjoyed the significant presence of Prince Charles II, that of Prince Nicolae and founder of Scouting in Romania, Professor Gheorghe Munteanu-Murgoci.<sup>5</sup>

The Constanța scouts participated in World War I battles, many bringing their ultimate sacrifice for the establishment of Greater Romania. Among them there were students and teachers of the "Mircea cel Bătrân" High School in Constanța.<sup>6</sup>

In this article we stop on a "memo notebook" from the first national jamboree, held in Piatra Neamț, between August 5-25, 1930. 27 cohorts and 7 legions participated in this assembly, totalling ca. 2000 scouts. There were also representatives of Germany, Poland, Hungary, France and Czechoslovakia.

Marin Gh. Benghiuș wrote that "*the main purpose of the Jamboree was to establish friendship between scouts, to learn and compare the understanding and improvement of each individual in relation to the collective life of the camp.*"

*The secondary goal was to make scouting and the benefits of the life in community known to the audience. Each cohort has organized its tents in the necessary terrain. In the tents the scouts prepared the food and ate and that is also where they slept.*"

The official opening of Jamboree took place on August 6, 1930, at 9 o'clock. The leadership of the Romanian Scout was represented by the commander of the Great Legion, prince Nicolae, his deputy, Ion Manolescu, Colonel Ulisse Samboteanu - the director of Scouts, Lt. Col. Panaitescu<sup>7</sup> - the director of the Jamboree. There was also N. Ioanu, the host town's mayor.

The Jamboree program included: the raising of the camp, the opening ceremony, contests, hiking, and the dismantling of the camp.<sup>8</sup>

Among the participants were representatives of "Ovidiu" Cohort from Constanța. The most prominent person in this "notebook" is the secretary of the mentioned cohort, Gheorghe Dragan. At this jamboree, the Marine Scouting Team of the "Ovidiu" cohort was responsible for the watch within the Direction for the Organization and Supervision of the Camp.<sup>9</sup>

The "album" of memories<sup>10</sup> is part of a donation by Marin Gh. Benghiuș, the "historian" of the Romanian Scouts, who had the good will to sell the "Romanian Scouts History", photo albums and important documents of the association to several museums in the country, including the Museum of National History and Archaeology from Constanța.

The cardboard document has ... pages where we find impressions of the jamboree participants. Among the signatories, we find names of scouts from different parts of the country and from abroad. I have not been able to decipher the signatures of some of those who have completed the pages of the book, but I have found some of the readable names in Marin Gh. Benghiuș's History.
