DECISION N. 188

For the Establishment and Organization of the Ecomuseal Research Institute of the Low Danube Tulcea

The Permanent Delegation of Tulcea County Council;

Taking into account the demand of "Danube Delta" Museum n. 1595/1992; Analyzing the reasons within the Report:

Taking into account the report n. 1209/18 March 1993 of the Department of

the Coordination of the Activity of the County Councils;

According to the article 59, paragraph 1 and article 64, paragraph 1 of the Law 69/1991 regarding the local public administration,

Decides:

Art. 1. The Ecomuseal Research Institute of the Low Danube - Tulcea is restablished through the reorganization of the "Danube Delta" Museum.

The Ecomuseal Research Institute of the Low Danube - Tulcea is a public institution, with juridical personality, subordinated to the County Council of Tulcea.

The Ecomuseal Research Institute of the Low Danube - Tulcea has its headquarters in Tulcea, 3, "14 Noiembrie" Street.

Art. 2. The aims of the Ecomuseal Research Institute of the Low Danube - Tulcea are:

a. The research of the north-Dobrudja Horst and of the Danube Delta in the goal of scientific, educational and touristic valuation.

b. Organizing of scientific, pedagogic, cultural and informative activities.

Art. 3. The Ecomuseal Research Institute of the Low Danube - Tulcea takes over the assets and liabilities of the former "Danube Delta" Museum.

The belongings comprised in the appendix 1a and 1b will be administrated by ICEM Tulcea as public goods.

Art. 4. The management of the Ecomuseal Research Institute of the Low Danube - Tulcea is entrusted to the Scientific Collegium and to the Executive Council.

The Chairman of the Scientific Collegium and of the Executive Council is the Director of the Institute.

The Director of ICEM Tulcea is appointed through a decision of the Permanent Delegation of Tulcea County Council.

Art. 5. The maximum number of employees, the organizing structure and the structure of the staff are established by the County Council and are approved by the Permanent Delegation of Tulcea County Council, according to the appendix included in the body of this Decision.

Art. 6. The wages of the staff are according to the law.

Art. 7. The employees of the "Danube Delta" Museum who are to be the staff of the Ecomuseal Research Institute of the Low Danube - Tulcea are considered as being transferred.

Art. 8. The organizing the working of the Ecomuseal Research Institute of the Low Danube - Tulcea are concordant to the Statute which is included within this Decision.

Art. 9. The institute will permanently keep the proper relationships with the General Direction of the Protection and Valuation of the National Cultural Heritage. The activity of research, conservation and museal valuation will be submitted to the current legislation.

Art. 10. The Direction of coordination the activity of the County Councils will convey a copy of this Decision to those who are interested to accomplish its stipulation.
